Picnic with the POPS

Saturday, July 2

Eat dinner before the departure, then enjoy beer, wine, snacks and dessert (cherry, apple and blueberry pies, what else?) with your friends at this great annual tradition. Day at the Lake Outing

Thursday, July 14

Departs 9:30 AM to Lake Monroe

Join us for this popular summer outing on Lake Monroe. We will cruise the lake, have a picnic lunch on the pontoon, and enjoy the beautiful scenery and natural wildlife around the lake. Cost of \$20 charged back, includes boat rental, food, beer, wine, sodas.

Overlooking the Ohio Overnight to Clifty Inn & Madison

Thursday, July 21 – Friday, July 22

Departs 8:00 AM

Our first stop is the Stream Cliff Herb Farm in Commiskey, IN, which dates back to 1821. We will visit the farm winery and wander the beautiful gardens and gift shop before eating lunch in the *Sprigs & Twigs Tea Room*. Then it's on to Hanover College for a guided tour of this beautiful campus overlooking the Ohio River. Founded in 1827, it is the oldest private 4-year college in the state of Indiana. In the afternoon we will check in to our river view rooms at Clifty Falls State Park. Enjoy the park inn and relax before departing for dinner at the historic Broadway Tavern, established in 1834 and one of Madison's most historic sites. On Day 2, after breakfast in the Falls Restaurant at Clifty Inn, we will visit additional sites in Madison, such as the Lanier Mansion, the Madison Railway Station, the Heritage Center and include a Madison Trolley Tour. After lunch at the Key West Shrimp House you will have time to wander through some of the shops in the Mainstreet Business District, a thriving and revitalized area of shops, restaurants and arts & crafts galleries. You may opt out of Day 2 activities in favor of staying at the Inn to play bridge, hike or just enjoy the park. Price of \$160 double and \$220 single includes motor coach transportation, escort, overnight accommodation, breakfast, all tours per itinerary, snacks & drinks on the bus. Guests add \$15. Return approximately 6:00 PM.

St. Mary of the Woods / Terre Haute Day Outing

Thursday, August 4

Departs 7:30 AM to Terre Haute

We will arrive at *St. Mary of the Woods* for a tour of the scenic wooded campus, including inside tours of the St. Anne Shell Chapel and the Church of the Immaculate Conception. We will see the National Shrine of St. Theodora Guerin, foundress of the Sisters of Providence and Indiana's first saint (canonized on October 15, 2006 by Pope Benedict XVI), and learn more about her life at the Heritage Museum, as well as visit the White Violet Center for Eco-Justice. The campus is also home to the Mary Hulman George School of Equine Studies, the only college equine program in Indiana and one of only 20 programs in the U.S. to offer a BS in equine studies. After a delicious buffet lunch at The Woods, we will take a guided tour of the Clabber Girl Museum and CANDLES Holocaust Museum before returning to Meadowood. Cost is \$25 (guests \$30).
